

How to create a pattern with the **PUFFY More** application ?

Enter the website either by clicking on the link provided in our web page, social media accounts, or typing **puffymore.com** in an internet browser.



You can convert any photo or pattern in your photo library into a template.

You can see the templates you have created before.

You can change the language option as you wish.

You can transform the patterns in the program into templates.

You may access to the template you worked lately by clicking on "Last Project" option. Then, you may continue knitting on which row you left working.



You can select any pattern from **READY PATTERNS** section and create the template.

You may adjust the image by holding it at the **BLUE FRAME** as you wish and decide what part of the image will be in the knit pattern.



You may adjust the width in **cm** or in number of loops by clicking on (+) or (-) buttons.

On the first line is the number of yarn balls needed for the chosen dimensions of knitting, and on the second, are the estimated measurements of the product you will knit. Here, you may check the dimensions of your knit.



You may choose, by clicking on, the colors of your preference for the product you will knit.



The **RED STRIPE** within the template shows the row presently worked.

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The numbers in the boxes shows how many of which color will be knitted on any particular row.

You have completed the knitting.

For much easier following the template, you can see the enlarged template and the red stripe below.



You can create a template not only with using the "ready patterns" option, but also by uploading photos or patterns yourself. For this click on the "Create New Pattern" option.



With the "Create New Pattern" option, you can convert any photo or pattern in your photo library into a template

Click on **Upload Photo** button and you may download a photograph taken by the camera, or chosen from the photo library.
